

## OMA reports a 12.2% increase in October 2023 passenger traffic

Mexico City, Mexico, November 6, 2023—Mexican airport operator Grupo Aeroportuario del Centro Norte, S.A.B. de C.V., known as OMA (NASDAQ: OMAB; BMV: OMA), reports that terminal passenger traffic at its 13 airports increased 12.2% in October 2023, as compared to October 2022. Domestic traffic increased 11.8%, and international traffic increased 15.5%.

October traffic results reflect the suspension of commercial operations in the Acapulco airport from October 25<sup>th</sup>, as a result of hurricane Otis.
