

OMA reports an 18.8% increase in April 2025 passenger traffic

Mexico City, Mexico, May 6, 2025—Mexican airport operator Grupo Aeroportuario del Centro Norte, S.A.B. de C.V., known as OMA (NASDAQ: OMAB; BMV: OMA), reports that terminal passenger traffic at its 13 airports increased 18.8% in April 2025, as compared to April 2024. Domestic traffic increased 17.5%, and international traffic increased 27.2%.
