

OMA Celebrates New Querétaro-Acapulco Route, Boosting Regional Connectivity and Tourism

ACAPULCO, **Mexico – December 5**, **2025** – Acapulco International Airport, part of the OMA network in Mexico, proudly welcomed the inaugural direct flight from Querétaro yesterday, December 4, 2025 operated by TAR México. This new route will offer two weekly frequencies, on Thursdays and Sundays, significantly enhancing air connectivity between the States of Querétaro and Guerrero.

This air service represents a key step in strengthening Acapulco's position as a top tourist destination and highlights OMA's commitment to regional development.

- The new flight strengthens air connectivity between Querétaro and Acapulco.
- The route is operated by TAR México with two weekly frequencies (Thursdays and Sundays).
- The new connection will drive tourism and economic growth for both regions.
