

OMA reports a 6.9% increase in December 2025 passenger traffic

Mexico City, Mexico, January 7, 2026—Mexican airport operator Grupo Aeroportuario del Centro Norte, S.A.B. de C.V., known as OMA (NASDAQ: OMAB; BMV: OMA), reports that terminal passenger traffic at its 13 airports increased 6.9% in December 2025, as compared to December 2024. Domestic traffic increased 6.9%, and international traffic grew 6.5%.
