

## ***OMA reports a 6.9% increase in May 2025 passenger traffic***

**Mexico City, Mexico, June 5, 2025**—Mexican airport operator Grupo Aeroportuario del Centro Norte, S.A.B. de C.V., known as OMA (NASDAQ: OMAB; BMV: OMA), reports that terminal passenger traffic at its 13 airports increased 6.9% in May 2025, as compared to May 2024. Domestic traffic increased 5.1%, and international traffic increased 19.5%.
